Advising to Support Professional Certification is for those who are advancing their credentialing in the early care and education field. Advisors will have time available during non-traditional hours to meet the needs of non-traditional students. Professional certifications can be but are not limited to the Child Development Associate (CDA) Credential, Family Child Care (FCC) Credential, and North Carolina Early Childhood Credential (NCECC). Topics commonly addressed during advising sessions can include but are not limited to: Navigating the higher education system, identifying career and educational goals, establishing a clear path to achieve goals and addressing challenges and finding appropriate supports or solutions. Dosage will vary based on the needs of the student. Training for advisors may vary based on local needs.
